We the educated youth of Chungthang North Sikkim would like to request your good self to register an FIR against Shri. Rakesh Tikait, spokesperson, Bhartiya Kisan Union of Uttar Pradesh, India under below mentioned points:

1. This is to bring to your notice the threatening statement made by Shri. Rakesh Tikait spokesperson, Bhartiya Kisan union of Uttar Pradesh, India, at a press conference in Bharatpur, Rajasthan on Saturday, 27th March 2021. He stated that he will cutoff power supply of 16 states if the Government of India does not agree to demands of the farmers by scrapping three farm laws in act by parliament. This statement is highly damaging and causing anguish and agony to the citizen of India and Sikkim in particular.

2. The statement is made in a reckless manner without consideration of the safety and security of the country and the requirements of the crores of people. Sikkim is a sensitive border state and such threatening statement made by Shri Rakesh Tikait is a clear threat to national security, as lots of pharma companies, power stations and other sensitive establishments is located in Sikkim. In addition of large number of army personal belonging to various units are also located in Sikkim besides para military forces like ITBP and SSB. The video clip of Shri Rakesh Tikait is viral on social media and can be referred to corroborate my statement.
