Sir/Madam,

That on 09/02/2021 at around 1940hrs a telephonic information was received from HC Om Prakash Poudyal of Adarshgaon-outpost informed that acting upon a reliable source information one Ramesh Chettri of Adarshgaon who is suspected to be in possession of Brown Sugar was intercepted by them and has been kept at Adarshgaon-outpost. After receipt of information self alongwith Police team proceeded to Adarshgaon South Sikkim for legal formalities.

After having reached Adarshgaon Outpost, the alleged identifying himself as Ramesh Chettri aged 32yrs. 5m Kharka Bdr. Chettri R/o Reshep South Sikkim who had been kept at Adarshgaon Outpost was appraised in writing in presence of two independent witnesses namely Milan Sharma and Indra Prasad Chettri to be searched in presence of Gazetted Officer or Magistrate whereas he opted to be searched in presence of a Gazetted Officer. Accordingly, due to unavailability of Gazetted Officer at Adarshgaon and its surrounding area, SHO Rangpo PS, PI Sameer Pradhan was informed to give his presence for conducting body search of the suspect Ramesh Chettri.

Upon his arrival at Adarshgaon Outpost, the body search of the suspect Ramesh Chettri was conducted in presence of the aforementioned witnesses during which two big transparent plastic pouch tied with a rubber band packed with a piece of newspaper separately containing light brown powder suspected to be brown sugar and one small brown colored pouch containing light brown powder suspected to be brown sugar weighing 17.260gms in total (alongwith plastic pouch) which had been concealed on a belt line of the black coloured trouser printed Redwan fashion medium size worn by the suspect Ramesh Chettri by making a hole on it were recovered from his possession. As such the recovered substances (brown powder suspected to be brown sugar) were weighed, seized, packed and sealed in presence of the aforementioned witnesses. Furthermore, the black trouser in which the seized exhibits had been concealed and one black Jio Mobile phone having Jio-SIM were also seized.

Various stages of seizure were photographed. Search and seizure started at 2125Hrs and ended at 2150Hrs.

The suspect Ramesh Chettri revealed that he had procured the said seized exhibits for delivery to one Nigma Sherpa of Adarshgaon, South Sikkim who was rounded up from Adarshgaon South Sikkim.

Hence, on the recovery of the aforementioned seized exhibits Temi PS Case no: 06/2021 Dated: 09/02/2021 U/S 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 is registered against Ramesh Chettri and Nigma Sherpa on Suo-motto and case endorsed to SI Roshan Pradhan for investigation.
