Madam,

This is to inform you that today while I was conducting routine checking of vehicles at Melli checkpost, a vehicle b/n SK 02 Z 0223 approached towards the checkpost from West Bengal side. The vehicle was being driven by Bir Bahadur Bhujel (later identified), age 25 yrs, S/O Man Bahadur Bhujel, R/O Daramdin, West Sikkim and was boarded by three other passengers viz. (i) Bishnu Pradhan, age 52 yrs, S/O Karna Bahadur Pradhan, R/O Soreng, West Sikkim (ii) Nikita Bhujel, age 19 yrs, D/O Ganesh Bhujel, R/O Gairigaon, Bijanbari, West Bengal and (iii) Esther Jogi, 20 yrs, D/O Kubirey Jogi, R/O Tinik, Chisopani, South Sikkim.

While the aforementioned passengers deborded the vehicle and proceeded towards the office of COVID Task Force to carry on with the formalities mandatory for the returnees, I started asking the driver some basic questions to which he answered nervously and started shivering. His act created suspicion about some wrong doing and thus I secured two independent witnesses namely Md. Ilyas and Guddu Kumar Rai and conducted the search of his vehicle and his person in presence of SDPO Jorethang duly observing requisite formalities. The search led to the recovery of 19 bottles of contraband cough syrup from the cavity on the left side of the boot space of the involved vehicle. Out of 19 bottles, 16 bottles are branded as "Cefrex" batch no. 031220-SD18 mfg. Jan/2021 exp. Dec/2022 and the remaining 3 bottles are branded as "PHENEREX" batch no. TBHU0223 mfg. 02/2021 exp. 01/2023. However nothing could be recovered from his person. It is pertinent to mention that the contraband substances were so smartly concealed that it was difficult to sight at the first instance. Upon recovery of the substances the driver could not provide any valid prescription to justify his possession.

The recovered items were seized, packed and sealed at the PO in presence of the witnesses.



Sir,

This is to inform you that today while I was conducting routine checking of vehicles at Melli checkpoint, a vehicle b/n SK 02 T 0694 (Chevrolet spark) approached towards the checkpoint from West Bengal side being driven by Sandeep Sewa (later identified). As a part of routine duty when I started checking the vehicle the driver in a nervous state tried to convince me that there is nothing inside the vehicle and also offered me to search his body. Thus I started frisking him but no any incriminating substances could be recovered from his person therefore I started checking his vehicle wherein I witnessed some controlled substances inside a sack kept in the boot space of the vehicle. Consequently without any delay I secured two independent witnesses namely Arun Sunar and Subash Chandra Rai and conducted thorough search of the vehicle wherein the undermentioned items were found concealed inside one white and blue coloured rice sack written "2005 Basmati Rice, Tiber" (i) 50 bottles of GWINPEX cough syrup, bearing batch No. TBHU0243, Mfg. date 02/2021, Exp. date 01/2023 (ii) 5 strips of Neurosun-10 tablets having 20 tablets in each strip totalling to 100 tablets, bearing batch No. DFC9976A, Mfg. date 01/2021, Exp. date 01/2023 (iii) 86 strips of Winspasma Forte, containing 8 capsules in each strip, totalling to 688 capsules, bearing batch No. WPS19025, Mfg. date sept. 2019, Exp. date Aug. 2021. (iv) 54 strips of Winspasma, containing 8 capsules in each strip, totalling to 752 capsules, bearing batch No. WPM19011, Mfg. date May 2019, Exp. date 2021.

Upon recovery of the above mentioned substances which were packed in bengali Newspaper, the driver could not provide any valid prescription to justify his possession hence, the same were seized, packed and sealed in presence of two independent witnesses.
