**REPORT**

Date: 13/03/2021

That today i.e 13/03/2021 at around 1515 Hrs a credible source information was received to the effect that one Arjun Subba of Barbotey, Chisopani is suspected to be selling contraband substances from his home located below CCCT Campus and requested for immediate intervention as there is every chances of parting away with the contraband substance if delayed. Subsequently, self along with the police team and 02 IRBn personnel proceeded towards Chisopani. Further, when the suspect Arjun Subba was confronted at his home, he attacked the police team with pointed scissor in order to escape and evade arrest as a result of which Ct. Sachin Thapa sustained injuries in his head and neck. The whole scenario was witnessed by co-villagers.

Thereafter, suspect person was given choice to be searched either in front of Magistrate or any Gazetted Officer, to which he wished to be searched in the presence of any gazetted officer. However, as the suspect couldn't read and write, the note regarding his wish to be searched in the presence of any Gazzetted officer was written by undersigned, explained to him in the presence of witnesses and as an acknowledgement his right thumb impression was put in the note. Accordingly, MEO/Jorethang Smt. Rajani Pega was requested to be available at the



Spot which she agreed and appeared therein. Thereafter, I offered myself to be searched by the witness Milan Gurung in the presence of another female witness Dhan Maya Kami and then I proceeded to search the above named suspects and his house wherein the following articles were recovered:


1. Thirteen (13) nos. of dry brown colored powder wrapped in white transparent paper suspected to be Brown Sugar weighing 6.12 grams concealed inside the elastic strap of a black and blue colored half pant written 'adidas' worn by the suspect.
2. Twelve (12) nos. of dry brown colored powder wrapped in white transparent paper suspected to be Brown Sugar weighing 2.38 grams concealed inside the elastic strap of a navy blue colored wollen track pant placed on the red colored sofa inside the house of suspect.
3. One Silver colored scissor broken into 03 pieces stained with blood.

Accordingly, the recovered contraband & narcotic/psychotropic substances along with a black and blue colored half pant, navy blue colored wollen track pant and scissor were photographed, seized, packed and sealed in the presence of aforementioned independent witnesses and gazetted officer.

On the recovery of above mentioned contraband & narcotic/psychotropic substance Jorethang PS FIR case no 11/2021 dated 13/03/2021 u/s 22 NDPS Act 1985 r/w sec. 307/353 IPC 1860 against Arjun Subba, 24 years, s/o Chandra Bdr. Subba r/o Barbotay, Chisopani, South Sikkim on Suo-Moto basis and case endorsed to SI Manish Gurung for further investigation.

13. Action taken: Since the above report reveals commission of offence(s) vide Entry No. 2, the case is registered and investigation is taken up/directed\* SI Manish Gurung to take up the investigation/transferred to PS ..... on account of jurisdiction.
