Today 06/12/2021 at 1145hrs while I was conducting routine checking of incoming and outgoing vehicle at Melli check post wherein a vehicle Br/No WB 73 F 7419(Truck) approached towards check post from West Bengal side. The vehicle was boarded with a driver Bhuwan Biswakarma (later identified) and occupant Abiney Subba (later identified). As a part of routine checking when I started checking the vehicle, the occupant started getting nervous. His body language created doubt in my mind of some wrong doing, thus I frisked the driver and the occupant. On frisking no incriminating items could be recovered from the possession of driver, however a black coloured plastic containing semi dried marijuana was recovered from the left inner pocket of jeans jacket worn by the occupant.

After the recovery when I questioned them the driver stated that he gave him lift from Adheri, West Bengal and had no idea as what he was carrying. Meanwhile Abiney Subba accepted that the item recovered belonged to him and added that he has kept more pouches of marijuana inside the vehicle of his brother Adarsh Subba which he was totally unaware of. On the basis of revelation made by him the vehicle (truck) SK 05 D 0217 driven by Adarsh Subba was also intercepted at the check post. Subsequently, the said vehicle was searched as per the provision laid down u/s 42 of NDPS Act without wasting extra time in presence of two independent witnesses namely Gyalchen Lepcha and Sambu Darjee. Upon checking three more black pouches containing semi dried marijuana concealed inside a Trapper backpack (Blue and grey) in colour was found on the seat behind the seat of the driver. Adarsh Subba along with helper Panjo Tamang also identified the bag pack belonging to Abiney Subba.

The recovered marijuana when weighed on a digital machine amounted to 401 grams in total. Out of the total quantity recovered 102grams of semi dried marijuana was recovered from the possession of Abiney Subba and remaining quantity was recovered from the vehicle of Adarsh Subba.

Subsequently, the items recovered was seized, sealed and packed at the Check post in presence of aforementioned witnesses along with vehicle (truck) SK 05 D 0217) driven by Adarsh Subba.
